

## **MEDIA PRODUCTION**

### **MP10S Grade 9 Introduction to Mass Media**

Students will study the effects of mass media on popular culture, and produce several short video projects.

### **MP20SA Grade 10 Fundamentals of Video Production**

This course will introduce students to all aspects of video production including storyboard creation, script writing, video camera operation, shot composition, and editing. Required course for all Grade 11 and 12 courses (Unless you have Modern Electronics from Silver Height Collegiate)

### **MP20SB Traditional Animation**

Students will study and create many styles of animation including stop-motion and claymation. Camera skills and editing techniques will be emphasized.

### **MP30SA Grade 11 Intermediate Video Production I**

Students will explore story-telling through video projects incorporating advanced production values such as lighting, sound design, and post-production.

### **MP30SB Intermediate Video Production II**

Students will create non-narrative video projects such as biographical, instructional, and editorial formats incorporating advanced production values such as lighting, sound design, and post-production.

### **MP40SA Grade 12 Journalism and Documentary Production**

Students will learn Electronic News Gathering techniques and create documentary videos. Emphasis will be placed on script preparation and copywriting.

### **MP40SB Advanced Post-Production Techniques**

Students will use Final Cut Pro editing software to learn advanced editing skills such as split screen, key frames, green screen, filters, and other special effects.
